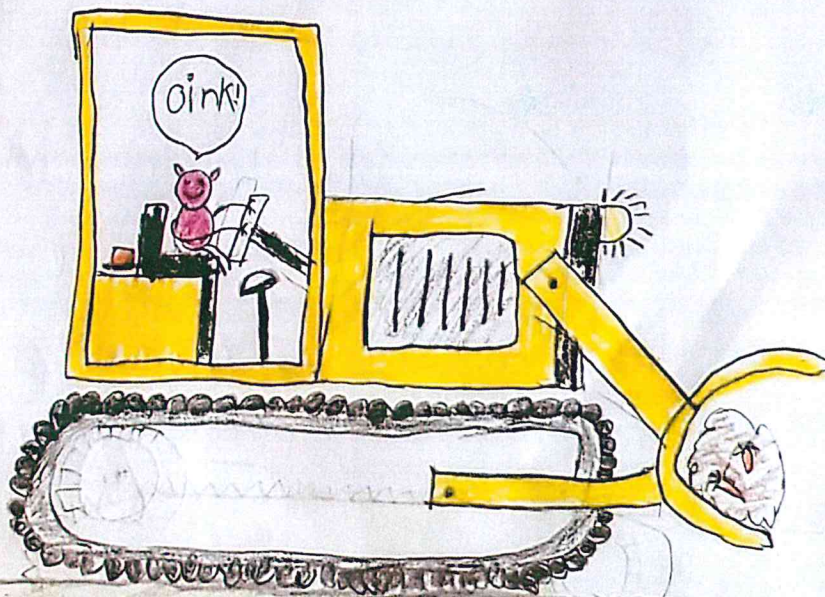
There once was a hard-working pig.
